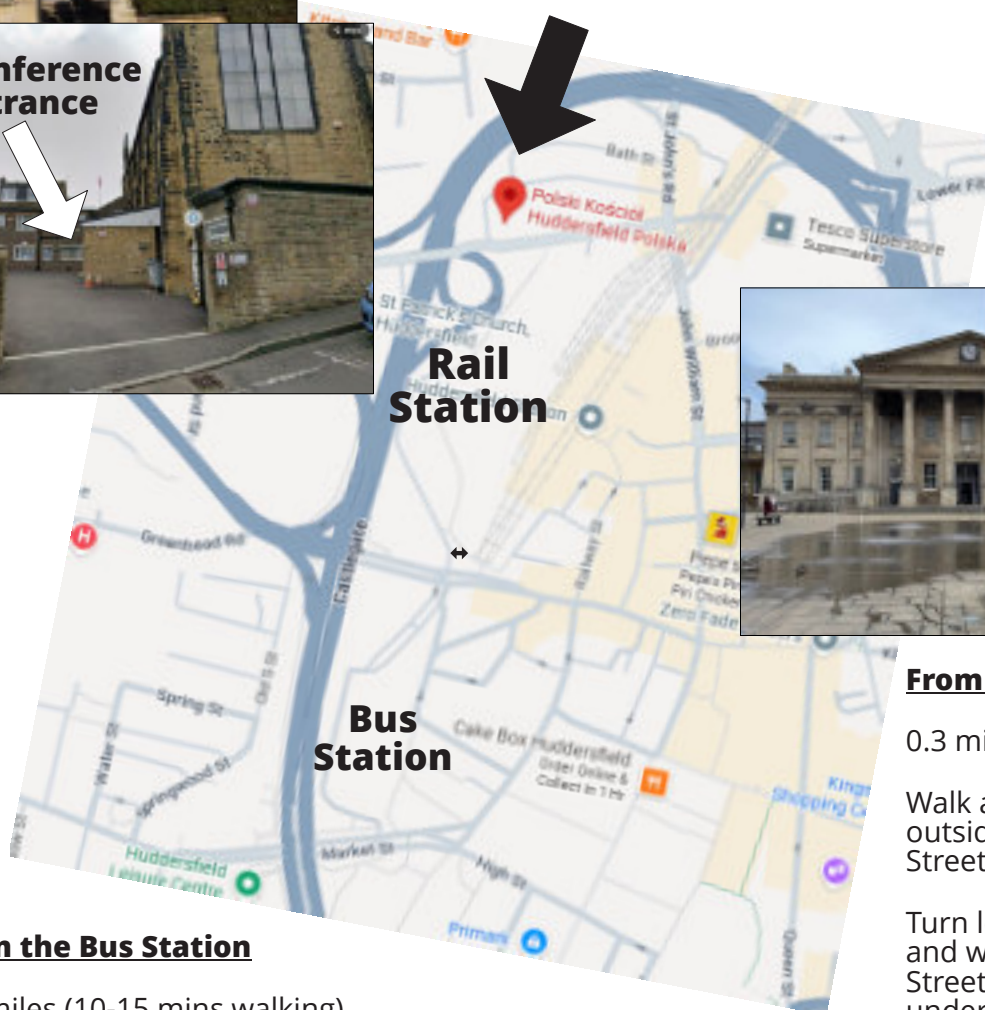


The Venue

Huddersfield Polish Church 88
Fitzwilliam St, Huddersfield HD1 5BB

The Hall and School entrance is round the back of the church on Rook Street - this is the entrance for the conference.

There is only a couple of place for disabled parking at the centre these will be for blue badge holders only.



From the Rail Station

0.3 miles (7-10 mins walking)

Walk across the public square outside towards John Williams Street.

Turn left at the George Hotel and walk along John Williams Street heading towards and under the Bridge.

Fitzwilliam Street will be on your left with 'the Sportsman beer house' on the corner.

Turn Left up Fitzwilliam Street, the Polish Church will be on your right after the Irish Centre. The Rook Street entrance is at the rear of the Church

From the Bus Station

0.5 miles (10-15 mins walking)

There are various routes the fastest is a footpath across the back of the rail station however this is secluded in spots and sections through Brunswick Street Car park have no footpath and it may not suit everyone.

Alternatively on foot you can head down Half Moon Street, down Westgate to John Williams Street and then along John Williams Street past the rail station, the George Hotel, Under the rail bridge and then left on to Fitzwilliam Street.
